Edwards School of Medicine have a defined process for supervision by a medical staff member of each Resident/Fellow in carrying out patient care responsibilities. This policy also ensures that all graduate medical education training programs have specific guidelines for circumstances and events when Resident/Fellows are to communicate with the supervising physicians.
